Hello Haviland Family!

School resumes on Wednesday, September 6. The first bell rings at **8:00 a.m.** for students to line up in the school yard in front of the sign showing their teacher's name. (Students should not arrive before 7:55 a.m.) All will enter the school on the 8:05 a.m. bell. **On the first day of school Kindergarten will begin at 9:00 a.m.**

**The first day of school is a 12:20 dismissal for all students.**

The hours of school are **8:05 a.m. to 2:35 p.m.** Kindergarten is dismissed at **2:25 p.m.** Students may not arrive at school before 7:55 a.m. This includes days of inclement weather. This is a matter of safety and supervision. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Crossing guards are stationed at Pine St. and Haviland Ave., Graisbury and Haviland Ave., and Merchant St. and Haviland Ave. Staff supervision on the school grounds begins at 8:00 a.m. when the first bell rings.

Please remember, in order to insure the safety of all our children, cars are **not permitted to park along the yellow curb in front of the school.** We must leave this area free for buses to enter, pick up or drop off students, and exit. Also, **NO PARKING** is permitted in the space designated **Bus Parking Only** and **Handicapped Bus Stop**. Please do not block the driveway used by the principal and school secretary. **Please note:** In order to reduce the flow of traffic, students in **Grade 1 will dismiss out back to Logan Avenue** on the first bell. On the second bell, **Grade 2 students will dismiss out front to Haviland Avenue. Each Kindergarten class will have a pick up place near the closest exit to the classroom.** Teachers will share this with you. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

The lunch program will begin on Thursday, September 7 for students in all grades. The cost of lunch is \$2.55 per ticket, 55 cents for milk. Snacks may also be purchased. A monthly calendar will be distributed indicating what is being served each day. Students may also bring a packed lunch. Please assist the lunchroom staff by packing food easily accessible to our younger students. In addition, please pack all food and drinks in **non-breakable** containers only. The lunch times will be as follows: **Kindergarten: 10:25 – 11:00; Grade 1: 11:05 – 11:40; Grade 2: 11:45 – 12:20.** (Breakfast is available for students, the cost is \$1.10 and served between 7:45 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. only.)


Money can be added to the child's lunch account in the all-purpose room each morning beginning at 7:55 a.m. **All students must then report to their line before re-entering the building at the bell at the start of the day.**

KEYS (Keep Elementary Youth Safe): Children must be registered before attending KEYS. There is a \$25.00 registration fee. **Note:** Children who may be attending both morning and afternoon child care programs must register for both programs. However, only one registration fee is required. A parent handbook will be distributed. **For information: Please call Michele Marchiano at 547-7695 ext. 4186.**
