Dear Parents and Guardians:

The Audubon Board of Education met Wednesday evening via video-conferencing. During the meeting the Board approved a change to the 2019-2020 school calendar (see attached). The last day of school for our Junior-Senior High School students will be on Wednesday, June 17, 2020. There will be no final exams for our Junior-Senior High School students. The last day for Haviland and Mansion students will be on Thursday, June 18, 2020. The floating teacher in-service day has been moved to June 19, 2020. The building principals will be sharing more information about the end of year events in the upcoming weeks.

Meal pick up, free of charge, is available to any students enrolled in our schools whose family is experiencing hardship as a result of COVID-19. Grab & Go meal pick up will be available from 10:00 AM through 12:00 Noon, on the following dates:

- Monday, May 18, 2020 - Four (4) Breakfast & Four (4) Lunch Meals
- Tuesday, May 26, 2020 - Four (4) Breakfast & Four (4) Lunch Meals
- Monday, June 1, 2020 - Five (5) Breakfast & Five (5) Lunch Meals
- Monday, June 8, 2020 - Five (5) Breakfast & Five (5) Lunch Meals
- Monday, June 15, 2020 - Four (4) Breakfast & Four (4) Lunch Meals

There will be no evening pick-ups. If you are interested in securing meals for your child(ren), during the school closure, please complete the weekly [Main District Survey](#). This lunch message will be shared weekly so we can be prepared with the appropriate amount of meals.

Meal pick-up will be located at the rear of the Junior-Senior High School. Vehicles are not permitted to enter through the gate. Students are to enter the Walnut Street gate by foot leading to the Football Stadium and go to the right. There will be a pick-up and distribution table near the rear Cafeteria exit/entrance. We ask that all families picking up meals respect the physical space of others and maintain proper social distancing; stay at least 6 feet away from others. Don't forget to wear your PPE (face mask) if picking-up meals.
