Meal pick up, free of charge, is available to any students enrolled in our schools whose family is experiencing hardship as a result of COVID-19. Grab & Go meal pick up will be available from 10:00 AM through 12:00 Noon, on Monday, June 8, 2020 - Five (5) Breakfast & Five (5) Lunch Meals. Meal pick-up will be located at the rear of the Junior-Senior High School. Vehicles are not permitted to enter through the gate. Students are to enter the Walnut Street gate by foot leading to the Football Stadium and go to the right. There will be a pick-up and distribution table near the rear Cafeteria exit/entrance. We ask that all families picking up meals respect the physical space of others and maintain proper social distancing; stay at least 6 feet away from others. Don't forget to wear your PPE (face mask) if picking-up meals.
