Dear Audubon School Family:

I am writing to inform you that a staff member who was assisting at the Junior-Senior High School with chromebook collection, school supplies/material returns, and yearbook distribution last week has tested positive for COVID-19. Based on the dates (Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday), times, and locations of their volunteer work, the staff member may have been in the proximity of students and family members across all grade levels (7 through 12).

The staff member was wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) (facemask) at all times during the distribution and collection of items. All students and family members were required to wear facemasks as well. After speaking with the Camden County Department of Health (DOH), these events were not defined as formal 'exposure' from the staff member to students and/or parents. The students and family members were not in close proximity for a prolonged period of time and all parties were wearing masks.

Based on my conversations with the DOH and after reviewing the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines and consultation with the District's attorney, I wanted to make sure everyone in the school community was aware. The CDC recommends that anyone that has been in close contact with someone with COVID-19:

- Be alert for symptoms. Watch for fever, cough, shortness of breath, or other [symptoms](#) of COVID-19 and
- Take your temperature and follow CDC guidelines if you have symptoms.

Our faculty and staff that have been exposed to COVID-19 are following the CDC guidelines for exposure, quarantine, and/or isolation.
