Dear Parents and Guardians:

We are now permitted to offer meals to students of any family experiencing a financial hardship as a result of COVID-19. The District will continue to offer meal pick up for two (2) breakfast and two (2) lunch meals on this **Monday, May 4** and three (3) breakfast and three (3) lunch meals on **Wednesday, May 6**. Meal pickups are available from 10:00 AM to 12:00 noon. **There will be no evening pick-ups.** (These protocols may be modified at any time, e.g. Memorial Day weekend service).

Students do not need to be present to pick up their meals for the week. The person picking up the food is required to know the student's full name as well school identification number. Whomever is picking up the meals must wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). In other words, **you must wear a mask when picking up meals.**

Out-of-District and Choice students can pick up their meals from local community sites.

If you are interested in continuing and/or securing free or reduced lunch meals for your child(ren), during the school closure, please complete the [Main District Survey](#).

If you are having difficulty getting to the school and qualify for Free & Reduced Priced meals, you are encouraged to fill out the survey [Requesting Delivery](#). All families will remain on the delivery list until the end of the School Closure. In other words, you do not have to fill out the delivery request each week. Meal delivery will only occur on Mondays between 10:00 AM and 11:00 AM; Monday deliveries will include the breakfast and lunch meals for the week (5 and 5).

Meal pick-up will be located at the rear of the Junior-Senior High School. Vehicles are not permitted to enter through the gate. Students are to enter the Walnut Street gate by foot leading to the Football Stadium and go to the right. There will be a pick-up and distribution table near the rear Cafeteria exit/entrance. We ask that all families picking up meals respect the physical space of others and maintain proper social distancing; stay at least 6 feet away from others. Don't forget to wear your PPE if picking-up meals.
